Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to announce we be using the Oyster Bay Community Swimming Pool at Joy Lane Primary School this year. Year 3 will start swimming on 9th January through until 13th February. Ideally the children will walk to Joy Lane but a decision will be taken on the day and at the time and we will use the minibuses if it's felt to be too cold.

The sessions have been booked on a Wednesday morning for 3 x one hour sessions, over 6 weeks. The first session is from 9:15 – 10:15am, second session is from 10:15 – 11:15am and third session from 11.15 – 12.15pm. Please be aware that swimming is part of the PE Curriculum and we would need a letter from you explaining why your child is unable to take part in the swimming lesson.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child brings their swimming costume, goggles and towel in on the correct day. Children must wear one piece swimming costumes or above the knee swimming shorts. Any pupil with hair that is shoulder length or longer needs to wear a swimming hat.
