

broadband. You can also use them to help you block or filter the content your child sees when searching online, and family friendly public WiFi can help when you're out and about.


Parental controls are also available to help you to plan what time of day your child can go online and how long for, stop them from downloading apps they are too young for and to manage the content different members of the family can see.
