#### Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a truly inspirational week here at WJS. The children have been learning about the struggles that some groups of people have faced in history. They have also learnt about some amazing people who have had a huge influence on the world in all manner of ways. People such as President Obama, Louis Armstrong and Ella Fitzgerald. We have had great discussions influenced by watching Obama's speeches and created beautiful art work by colouring large pictures of the people we have looked at in different colours.
