




## A message from the Headteacher...

Dear Parents and Carers,

This week Year 6 have been developing their understanding of the symbols that represent the components of a circuit, as well as investigating the levels of light emitted by circuits when the number of bulbs is changed. They have also delved into the artwork seen in Mosques and the link this has to religion. In art, the children have been focusing on proportion and the fine details of faces, which has produced some amazing artwork. Just look at the pencil portrait art in the photo.



Year 5 have been challenging themselves, as they began their journey into developing their understanding of tricky fractions, particularly mastering Equivalent Fractions. They have also investigated and developed their understanding of different Viking characters and studied Athelstan, the first King of England!
