## A message from the Headteacher...

Dear Parents and Carers,

Well the final week of term 3 has been no exception to the rest. This week we had our amazing WJS Art Exhibition, showcasing every child's art work from our Winter Themed Art Week. The exhibits were truly breath-taking and demonstrated the huge skill and passion the children and staff of WJS have for the arts. We had animation, modelling, sketching, painting, dioramas and much more. Thank you for coming along and getting a bit squashed, next time we will be in the hall!







This week year 6 have been astonished to find out that we had one of the first steam train lines in Kent and have produced some wonderful newspaper reports inspired by the event. They have also been debating whether art and architecture is more relevant to religion than generosity and charity, which has divided opinions within year 6. The children also demonstrated their understanding of electricity through designing their own investigation that tested wires and their effect on the brightness of a bulb. They have also developed their understanding of how to manage their risks online through our exciting E-Safety workshops.

In Year 5, the children have concluded their amazing epic sagas. They have ensured that they showed their understanding of the Viking era through their word choice and plot. They have also worked on mastering their accuracy and speed with regards to their arithmetic ability and lastly they have investigated the Bayeux Tapestry as a source of information about the Battle of Hastings and the last Viking King.

Year 3 have created delicious "metallic" menus for a meal that the Iron Man would enjoy. In Design Technology, the children made pneumatic circus people. They had tightrope walkers and clowns doing all sorts of tricks! The children made use of our wonderful outdoor learning space to do some code breaking using their geography mapping skills and finally in maths, the children enjoyed using shop role-play to learn about adding and subtracting money.

Year 4 made terracotta warriors using red clay and created top trumps cards for the Terracotta Army. They enjoyed a Chinese feast to celebrate their learning of the Shang Dynasty. The children had the opportunity to try noodles, prawn crackers and green tea. The children experiencing traditional Chinese games in the playground followed this.
