If you do not use the SurveyMonkey link to register your child's attendance we will be taking that as your decision NOT to send your child in to school the next week. Late emails requesting children do attend will I am afraid not be accepted. We are having to plan staffing very carefully in line with our strict Risk Assessment. I am sorry we cannot be more flexible and I am sure you understand.

The rest of this letter is only relevant should your child be returning to school. Social distancing will be taught and encouraged but I cannot guarantee this and the Government guidance acknowledges this.

- Children are in "bubbles" of 15 children maximum. You will be informed on Friday which bubble they are in and given information for the following week regarding start times, what they need etc.
- The school day will finish early every Friday (from Ipm). If you are a Key Worker please let us know on the registration form that you cannot make arrangements for your child to leave early on Fridays. We hope you understand how important it is for us to be able to deep clean the premises.
