ACTIVITY WEEK – YEAR 6 – Monday 3rd – Friday 7th June

Dear Parents

While the rest of the year group are away at Grosvenor Hall we have arranged an exciting programme of activities for your children.

Monday 3rd June – Sports/Whitstable Trail & Beach Art Competition

We are going to join with the other year 6 children and do some sports with Mr Kidd before they go off to Grosvenor Hall, we shall then divide into small groups and complete the Whitstable Trail, ending on the beach for a picnic lunch then some beach art fun – with prizes available for the best creation! Children will need to bring a packed lunch, sunhat and suncream and a raincoat.

Tuesday 4th June – Wildwood

We are visiting Wildwood to see the animals and play in the play area. Travel will be by school minibuses. Packed lunch will be needed. There will also be the opportunity for the children to use the Drop Slide if they so wish, so please bear this in mind. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, sunhat and suncream and a raincoat and wear long sleeves and long trousers.

Wednesday 5th June - Crazy Golf @ Rascal Bay, Manston

We will be playing crazy golf at Rascal Bay Adventure Golf Centre in Manston and then having our picnic lunch at the Viking Ship at Pegwell Bay. Travel will be by school minibuses. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, sunhat and suncream and a raincoat.

Thursday 6th June – Powell Cotton Museum, Birchington

We will be walking round the museum doing a museum safari and handling some exciting objects, we will then have our packed lunches in the grounds. Travel will be by school minibuses. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, sunhat and suncream and a raincoat.

Friday 7th June - Faversham Swimming Pool

We shall be going to Faversham by train, then walk to the swimming pool for a day of swimming, we shall have a picnic packed lunch and then come back to school. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, sunhat and suncream and a raincoat along with swimming kit.

Cost

The cost for all these activities is £25.00 per child. We have tried to keep the cost to a minimum but still have a varied programme which the children will enjoy, we will be using both our new minibuses for travelling, so please note on the form if your child suffers from travel sickness and provide the correct medication in a named envelope.

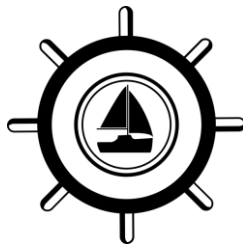
Payments can be made by cash or cheque to the school office or via the School Money Online payments system. Online payments will be available from Wednesday 15th May 2019.
