Dear Parents and Carers,

I can't believe we are nearly in October. Time is flying by. Lots of fabulous learning this week happening. Year 4 have been using outdoor learning to create their own rivers by using the knowledge they have learned in Literacy and Topic lessons. Year 3 have enjoyed finding out how Christians practise their faith within the home and the church. They looked at the activities that take place in the churches within our community.

In upper school Year 5 have been busy creating waves, using sand trays and water bottles, in order to learn more about the two different types of waves: Constructive and Destructive. They have started writing letters to different people about reducing and stopping plastic getting into our ocean, a very topical subject. In Art, they have investigated Seurat and created their own Pointillism colour wheels using the primary colours.

Year 6, have been empathising with the characters in their books, by writing recounts of the issues faced by the stranded children in the Amazon and imagining what life must be like for Harry Potter living as a 'muggle'. They have been demonstrating just what amazing mathematicians they are by completing many word problems based on the four operations as well as learning all about the Linnaeus system, the intricate layers of the rainforest and all those that live in it. Next week they will be visiting our local woods to investigate ecosystems found there and comparing them to the rainforest.

There was great interest in the Adult Taster Session for helping your child with their maths. It was good to see so many parents wanting to know how their children learn. 
