Dear Parents and Carers,

Christmas arrived at WJS this week. Our lovely Christmas tree was delivered and decorated by children. A huge thank you to Mr T, from Inclusive Sports, who kindly donated the tree. It looks really beautiful in our hall. Year 5 children were transported to space in the Planetarium which filled our hall to the ceiling. I had a quick peak inside and it brought back memories of taking my own class into one many "moons" ago! The children learnt about the Space Station, the planets and the stars. It was a truly cosmic day.

Year 6 have been using everyday utensils, such as tweezers to represent birds beak shapes as studied by Darwin in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. They wanted to see which beak picked up food the easiest and they had to compete against each other and work out each average! In year 4 the children created tornadoes in bottles, to understand the destructive nature of a swirling vortex!

Next week is Democracy Week for the children at WJS. In keeping with what is happening nationally, we will be exploring the background, and history, of the UK Parliament and exploring how a General Election works. During the week, Year 6 will have the exciting opportunity to develop their own Political Parties (not in any way connected to the current UK parties) and then write their own Manifestos based on 3 main topics which could affect them. Firstly, they will consider how school lunchtimes could be enriched and adapted. Secondly, they will consider the current subjects/topics that are taught in school and which ones they might feel are less important and what they would replace them with. Lastly, they are going to consider the facilities they would introduce into Whitstable to further support the young community.

These manifestos will be shared in our own Hustings Assembly on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December at 10 am, where the leaders of our political parties will try to persuade the rest of the school to vote for them. Later in the day, children will be given their own voting cards and a chance to take part in our very own WJS Election, where they will be able to secretly vote for their favourite Year 6 party; results will be announced on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December and then the winning party leader will meet with myself to discuss their manifesto priorities further. I am really looking forward to seeing the children take part in this.

I also wanted to say a huge well done to the girl's football team who won their first match this week.
