

Light Build-a-Book Task



This task sees you become an author and illustrator to create your own book about light!

Your book should be a non-fiction book all about light, including shadows, reflection, refraction and colour.

Follow the instructions below to make a book out of paper. Then design a front cover, add a blurb to the back cover, and start writing! You may want to include information about what light is, how it travels, how shadows are made and ways they can change, how light reflects and how this enables us to see, what makes light refract and how we see colours.

You should add illustrations and diagrams to make your book attractive and easy to understand. Some of you may even want to try adding a pop-up page to your book!

How to Build-a-Book

Fold the paper along the dashed lines.

Page number 1 is your cover, pages 2 and 3 are your pages about light and page 4 is your blurb.

Give your book a title on page 1 and add content to the lines on pages 2 and 3. You might want to summarise what your book is about on the lines on page 4.

Add illustrations and diagrams in the boxes to help explain the information. Make sure your illustration on the front cover is eye catching!
