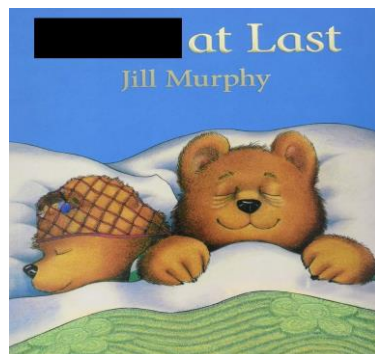
Round 9 – WHAT'S THE MISSING WORD FROM EACH BOOK COVER?



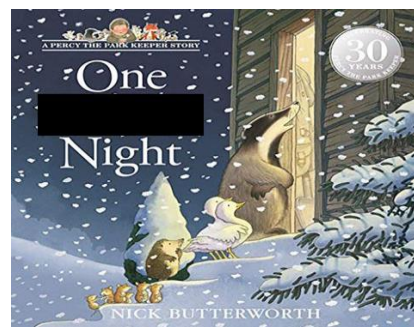

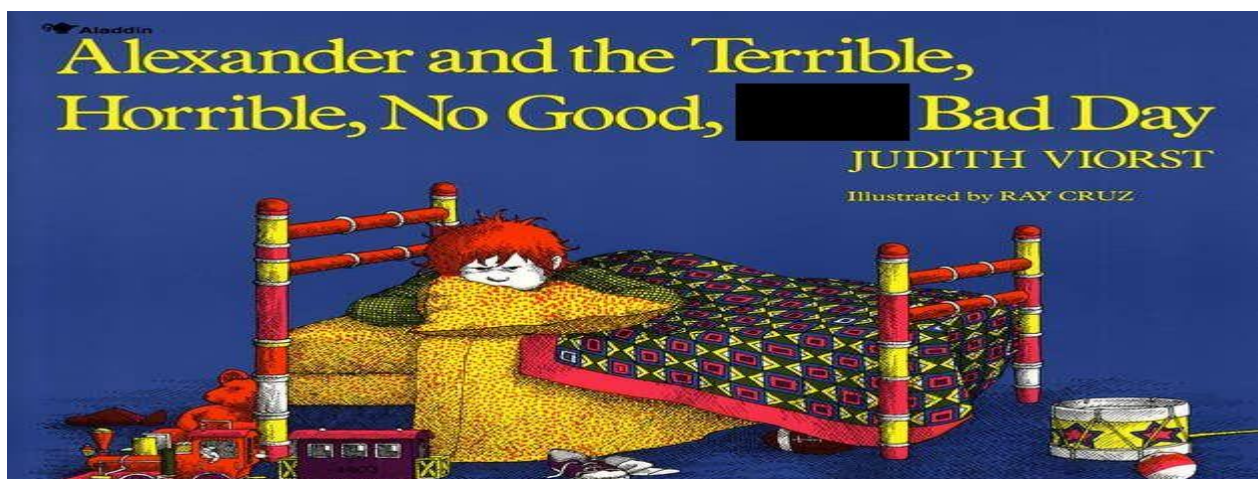
