outside. Inspired by these activities the children had to write instructions on how to make a

cloud maker. The ideas were incredible. In geography the children are learning about rivers and Beau painted a fantastic river in the art lesson this week. Fantastic art work.





Year 5 were lucky enough to have a visit from our resident photography expert Mr Rick (also known as our caretaker). He showed them many types of cameras from past and present and talked them through the history of photography. They then went on to write about how cameras had

Year 6 have been having fun immersing themselves in what it must have been like being stranded in the Amazon Rainforest. They wrote diary entries as their favourite characters.
