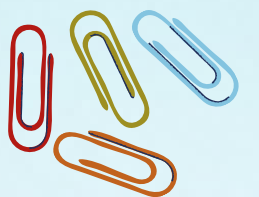




Let's get back to school!



A safe return

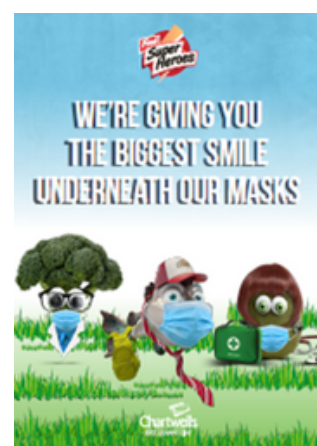

What's new?

- To help ensure we can effectively social distance, year groups may be invited to lunch at staggered times to ensure children can enjoy their meals with friends at a safe distance from each other.
- In some schools, your child may be enjoying their lunch in a room other than the dining hall to help maintain social distancing.
- Some schools may ask our cooks and serving staff to wear face masks – please be assured this is just an extra safety measure.
- Around the school and dining room there will be child friendly signage highlighting social distancing measures e.g. standing 2m apart and only one child on the stairs at a time.
- At meal times, children will be asked to sit 2m apart from each other.
- Meal options will be slightly reduced during this period of time but they will still be as tasty as ever!
- Some schools may add additional meal times to the school day such as breakfast, mid-morning snack, and an afternoon snack.
