A message from the headteacher...

Dear Parents and Carers,

What a lovely end to the week with the sun shining and blue sky, even though it is a bit nippy. We hope your children have enjoyed the live lessons that started this week. We have had some lovely feedback about how these have helped to structure your days of home-learning. Later in the term I will gather your feedback on the remote learning we have provided at WJS.

We have had 29 laptops to give to families that found accessing the online learning difficult and these have made a real difference. 24 of these laptops were provided by the Government and the other 5 were as a result of the huge generosity of a member of the public who lives in Whitstable. I was contacted to ask if we could use a donation for lap tops, I of course said yes please. I then received 5 brand new Chrome Books a few days later. This kindness has warmed everyone's hearts here at WJS.

Next week we start the Lateral Flow Device (LFD) home-testing **for staff**. This is a voluntary, twice weekly COVID-19 test, for all staff who are coming onto the school site. Staff will be self-testing before the school day starts on Mondays and Thursdays. These are the optimum times to ensure that any staff who have been infected by COVID-19 can be identified as the viral loads is at its highest at this time. Staff who are identified as positive on Thursday morning could result in a bubble closure and we appreciate this may result in short notice for parents but will do our best to contact you as quickly as possible. Others who share the family home with the children who are sent home to self-isolate do not have to self-isolate unless the children present with symptoms or a positive test.

I am just sorting out the term dates for the next academic year and I will let you know what these are in the next few weeks. I know that some people are thinking ahead to holidays that they may want to book, fingers crossed that holidays will be something we can all enjoy in the not-too-distant future. Finally, thank you again for the unwavering support you have given the school over these last few weeks. We really appreciate every message and hope you too feel supported by us.
