There will be 150 places open to Y7 only in September 2022 and the School is sited on Spring Lane, Canterbury on the former Chaucer School site.

The Trust lead school is Barton Court Grammar School which will work closely and collaboratively with Barton Manor School sharing Senior Leaders, Middle Leaders, teachers and support staff. The Trust also sponsors The Charles Dickens School, a non-selective co-educational school in Broadstairs which will also support the development of Barton Manor.
