6H Swimming Lessons during Term 6 2022

We are pleased to be able to advise that we are commencing swimming lessons at the Whitstable Active Life Swimming Pool, starting on **Tuesday 7**th **June to 5**th **July. 6H will swim from 2.30pm to 3pm.** Due to the finish time, 6H may arrive back to school slightly later by 10 minutes. We will ensure the bottom gates remain open for you to collect your child from the playground as usual. Alternatively, should you wish to collect your child from the swimming pool at 3pm then please state this on the form below. Please note, unless you have indicated "collect from pool" then all children will be taken back to school where they can be collected or walk home unaccompanied as usual; they cannot leave the pool unaccompanied at 3pm.

Each class will swim in 3 groups with one instructor per group. Please be aware that swimming is part of the PE Curriculum and we would need a letter from you explaining why your child is unable to take part in the swimming lesson. Please ensure that your child brings their swimming costume, goggles and towel in on the correct day. Children must wear one piece swimming costumes or above the knee swimming shorts. Any pupil with hair that is shoulder length or longer will need to wear a swimming hat.
