Mental Health Support for Primary Age Children in Whitstable, Herne Bay and Reculver

All children may experience challenge in their life where they would benefit from counselling and support. We are delighted to partner with the Coastal Family Hub, a new local charity that has been set up to enable professional counsellors to work in our Herne Bay and Whitstable schools.

The Coastal Family Hub has been created by education experts, health professionals, psychiatrists and experienced counsellors. We recognise that there is a need to support our children and enable good mental health. The Coastal Family Hub aims to support children and families in schools.

Unfortunately there is no government funding for this but as the CACOT group of schools we feel this is a priority.

In order to drive this initiative the Coastal Family Hub aim to raise money to match fund school contributions thus reducing the cost of accessing the counselling service for schools (which is supplied by a charity called Fegans).

How can you help?

In order to fund this much-needed counselling in our local schools, we are asking our school community if they would consider giving a one off or regular donation to the Coastal Family Hub. 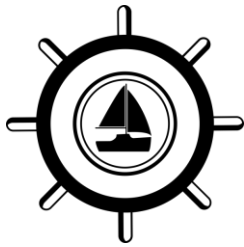
