Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware the long awaited trip to Harry Potter World on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> July is nearly upon us so please see below for the organisational details for the actual day:

- Please arrive at the bottom gate (by the playground) at **7.30am** so that your child can go straight to their classroom to be registered. The gate will be open for 15 minutes as we plan to leave at 8am.
- Your child should be **school uniform**, with comfortable shoes.
- Please provide a lunch, snacks and water in a bag that can be carried on their back, or certainly allows for their hands to be free. They will carry this during the visit but the lunch can be disposed of after lunch.
- Please **do not** allow your child to bring with them any valuable electronic device, such as a camera, ipod or mobile phone.
- Please **do not send any money** with your child: the shop is very expensive so we recommend that should your child see something they would like to buy then they wait until they are home and you can order it online.
- Should your child require **travel sickness medication**, please can this be put into an envelope/bag with their name, class, dosage and time clearly marked. This will need to be given to their class teacher.
- Please ensure that there is an adult to collect your child at **approximately 5pm** from the top gates (by the office). All children must go home with an adult due to the time. We will send a text out to all parents/carers approximately 30 minutes before we are due back to school and keep you updated of any traffic related issues that may alter the proposed time of 5pm.
