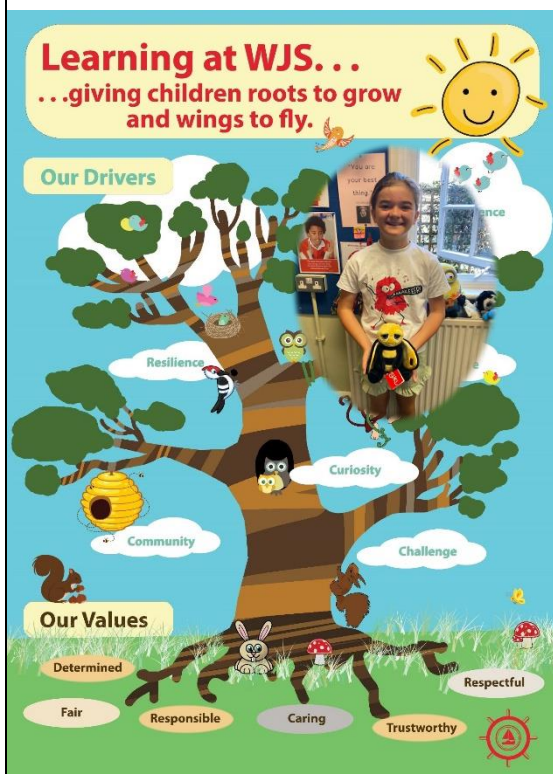

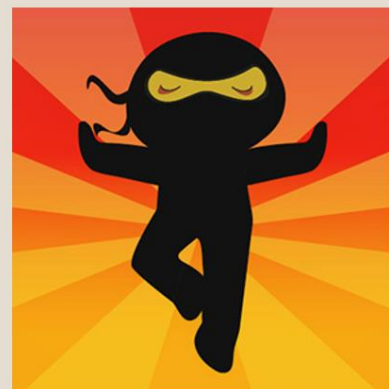

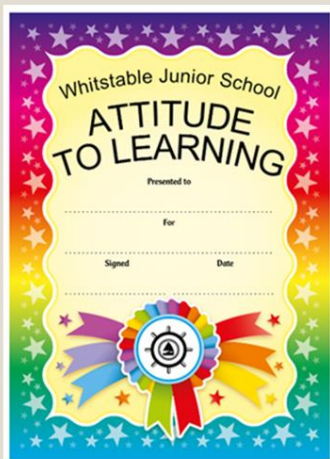


Attitude to Learning...

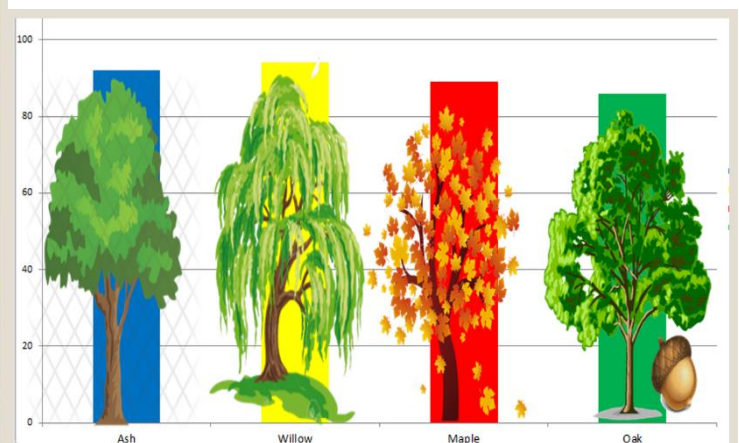
