- We are a Junior School and our children join us at the start of year 3 and leave at the end of Year 6.
- From September 2023 we will be a school with 8 classes. 2 in each year group.
- We have Pupil Admission Number of 60
- The majority of our children join us from either St Alphege Infant School or Westmeads Infant School but we do have children from other school's join us too.






- Our last Ofsted was June 2019- Good School- the developmental point was to continue working on embedding our enriched curriculum.
- Academically the school performs above the National % for attainment and also exceeds the National measure for the progress that children are expected to make.
- Kent Test- we fit the county picture of about 20-25% of children passing the Kent Test and moving on to grammar schools at the end of Year 6.
