## What have the children been up to this week?

This week, Year 3 have been enjoying exploring their new story book: 'Boot'. This has involved some incredible verb spotting challenges and some creative drama scenes to predict what may lie ahead in

the text. The children have also started planning for some exciting things next week, including their DT 'pop up' books and a magnet game to consolidate their Science learning.

This week, in Year 4 the children have been learning to divide 2 and 3 digit numbers using the bus stop method and they have continued reading our book: 'The Thieves of Ostia'. They have also put their maths skills to good use, enjoying a brilliant trip to the local park to measure play equipment as part of Number Day! In Science, they are continuing to learn lots of fascinating facts



about the digestive system and they have also been finding out why the Romans invaded Britain, three times!

In Year 5, the children have been thoroughly entertained with wonderful story-telling, as well as investigating water resistance and designing and making boats that were streamlined. They loved working in teams to create their boats and could explain how they would move through the water. In Year 6, the children have been describing dragons related to their new

topic: how to train your dragon. In maths, they have started exploring algebra by writing and drawing expressions. They have also continued their bread making adventures and are planning their final bake, whilst in RE we have designed a church for the modern age.
