The dates and times of the trip are as follows:

Due to trip timings, there will be no impact on the time children need to be at school or when they will leave to go home. We will be travelling to Faversham using the school minibuses.

As this is an outside activity, the children will need to come to school in **outdoor learning**type clothing <u>with a change of footwear (ideally sturdy shoes/boots or wellies)</u>, with an appropriate coat for the weather.

Children will have an earlier lunch on this day: weather permitting at the Otterden Centre in their lovely surroundings, or at school if the weather is unsettled. Therefore, can you provide your child with a packed lunch and drink in a named bag or their normal school bag.
