YEAR 6 Enrichment Activities – Monday 26th June – Wednesday 28th June 2023

Dear Parents

While the rest of the year group are away at Gilwell Park we have arranged an exciting programme of activities for your children.

Please note that the children can be in non-school uniform during these activities, plus whatever guidance is given for each day.

Monday 26th June – Swalecliffe Forest School & Beach Art Competition

The children are going to take a walk along the beach and complete some beach art – with prizes available for the best creation! Before visiting the amazing Forest School at Swalecliffe Primary School. They will then walk back along the beach to school – looking for key landmarks and solving puzzles.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch (or order one from school – please see attached form), sunhat and suncream or a raincoat, weather dependent and comfortable shoes.

Tuesday 27th June – Canterbury by bus

The children will be visiting the main areas of interest during this action-packed day in Canterbury. They will begin by catching the bus to the bus station, before visiting the Cathedral, taking a walk along the river, visiting the adventure park and being given the opportunity to buy a £2 item from PoundLand. The children will then catch the bus back to school.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch (or order one from school – please see attached form), sunhat and suncream or a raincoat, weather dependent and comfortable shoes and £2 in a named and sealed envelope.

Wednesday 28th June – Turner Contemporary by train

The children will take the train to Margate, where they will have lunch on the beach, before visiting the amazing Turner Contemporary Gallery to complete a tour and art activity. The children will then take the train back to Whitstable, before walking back to school.

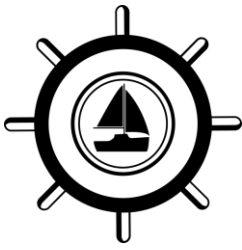
Children will need to bring a packed lunch (or order one from school – please see attached form), sunhat and suncream or a raincoat, weather dependent and comfortable shoes
