



## What have the children been up to this week?

This week in Year 3 the children have been learning about perimeter in maths and continuing to read and write about the exciting adventures of Boot! In history they have been looking at how people in the Indus Valley lived and in science they have been enjoying more fun with magnets, making their games and trying them out. They are also excited about making their own moving monsters this week in DT and putting their knowledge of pneumatics to the test! Year 4 have been writing persuasive leaflets, encouraging tourists to visit the wonders of Ancient China. In maths they have been comparing metres and kilometres. In addition, and rather excitingly, they have been creating their own versions of terracotta warriors. Each class finished their fantastic dance topics in PE with wonderful final performances and they have continued to explore the ins (and outs) of the digestive system in science. Year 5 have had a busy week writing exciting Greek Myths, sending their Heroes off on quests and to solve problems. They had scary mythological monster descriptions which lead into powerful fight scenes. Furthermore, the children have been debating, and have written, a balanced argument about whether it is better to live in Sparta or Athens. In maths the children returned to fractions: multiplying Unit and Non-unit fractions by Integers and in science they designed their own mechanisms to help with an assortment of jobs using levers, pulleys and gears. Year 6 have shown great resilience, determination and smiled in the face of challenge practising their SATs. They have also written vibrant descriptions of dragons from How to Train Your Dragon and researched South American countries for geography. As it is Children's Mental Health Week, the children have been investigating the phrase 'My Voice Matters' and responding with artworks and discussions.
